

Criteria for awarding doctoral scholarship for the first year of studies acknowledged by the Council of the Faculty of Physics, Astronomy and Informatics on 21.03.2018

1. The criteria and rules apply to the participants of Doctoral Study during the first year of studies at the Faculty of Physics, Astronomy and Informatics (hereinafter referred to as WFAiIS). Scholarships are awarded on the basis of the regulation by the Minister of Science and Higher Education from 9 August 2017 on doctoral studies and scholarships (Journal of Laws from 2017, item 1696). The final ranking list is recommended by the Doctoral Study Commission, in cooperation with the Faculty Doctoral Scholarship Commission, the Head of Doctoral Study and the Dean of WFAiIS.
2. The Doctoral Study Commission includes at least three academic teachers employed by WFAiIS who have the academic degree of at least Ph.D., including the Head of Doctoral Study and a representative of doctoral students nominated by the Faculty Council of Doctoral Students.
3. The Dean of WFAiIS sets the number of scholarships per a study program (1. Physics, 2. Physics and Biophysics), for which separate rankings are made. The total number of scholarships is at least 50% of the doctoral students admitted for first year.
4. The ranking lists are made during the meeting of a commission which includes the Dean, the Head of Doctoral Study and members of the Doctoral Scholarship Commission. The basis for the formulation of the ranking lists are the doctoral student's results during the recruitment process, taking into account all its stages.
5. Doctoral scholarships on the first year of studies are awarded based on the ranking lists from points 3 and 4.
6. Application for a doctoral scholarship should include the student's personal data: name, surname, Polish Resident Identification Number (PESEL), and in case of not having it- the number of document confirming identity, and the year of doctoral studies.
7. The total amount of scientific scholarships received by a single doctoral student, namely a doctoral scholarship awarded on the basis of Article 200 of Higher Education Law, and a scholarship for doctoral students participating in research of developmental studies awarded on the basis of Article 19, section 2 of the Act from 30 April 2010 on the rules of funding science, coming from the resources of WFAiIS cannot exceed 2000PLN per month.
8. The aforementioned criteria and rules are in force since the day of being passed by the Council of WFAiIS
